1. Free Wifi Usage Policy

Bagworth Community Centre Trust 2013 Limited provides free WiFi access in Bagworth Community Centre for use by its customers. Use of this service is conditional on compliance with the following usage policy:

We will use our reasonable endeavours to ensure that you are provided with free, uninterrupted service while the Community Centre is staffed. We will not be liable however, for any reason if the service is not available at any time for any period, nor for any loss of data or damage to the equipment you suffer as a result of using our service.

The service we provide is intended to be used for general purposes, including accessing the World Wide Web, email, messaging services and chat rooms. You undertake to us that you will use the services responsibly and that you will behave in a lawful, honest and proper manner when accessing the services. Without prejudice to any other provision of this agreement, we may terminate your use of the service at any time without notice if we become aware of any behaviour that has a negative effect on our equipment or network or the use by other customers of our equipment or network or the internet in general, or which damages, or has the potential to damage, our reputation.

Without prejudice to the generality of the preceding paragraph, you may not: use the service for any illegal purpose (including but not limited to breaching any intellectual property or computer misuse legislation and downloading or uploading any illegal material); send any unsolicited commercial email (or "spam") or any activity relating to it; carry out any "hacking" activities such as attempting to access systems without authorization or carry out denial of service attacks.

You must refrain from gambling or accessing adult material of any kind.

You must terminate using the service if asked to do so by a trustee, member of staff or volunteer of the Bagworth Community Centre. No reason is required to be given.

2. Electrical Equipment Charging Policy

BCCT 2013 are happy for our customers to charge their mobile phones, laptops and other portable electrical equipment whilst they are using the Community Centre facilities. This would be done at their own risk, we will not be liable for any damage that may occur to a customer's device as a result of plugging the device into an electrical socket in the Community Centre. Whilst a device is charging it must not be left unattended. In addition the customer must not create a health and safety hazard

(such as a trip hazard due to a trailing lead or equipment left unattended on the floor). The customer must unplug the device if asked to do so by a trustee, member of staff or volunteer of the Bagworth Community Centre. No reason is required to be given. BCCT 2013 reserve the right for any trustee, member of staff or volunteer to unplug and remove any unattended equipment to a safe location.
